Fellow Parents,

On behalf of your P&C Association, I would like to take this opportunity to wish your family an exciting and rewarding year ahead at Nedlands Primary School.

Each year the P&C Association makes a substantial grant to the School - in 2016 it amounted to over \$81,000. The majority of this grant was spent on top oval playground and fencing and the bike education program. These additional resources allowing NPS teaching staff to direct more individualized attention to students and undertake more challenging activities with their classes. As a result our children enjoy a more engaging learning experience, which I'm sure you will agree is worth supporting!

The P&C grant was also spent on other uses such as Athletics licences for all students, additional I.T. facilities, Year 6 graduation prizes, musical instruments, and library books.

In addition the P&C provides ongoing services to school community, like the Uniform Shop and the operation and maintenance of the school onsite swimming pool – the benefits of which include less 'lost class time' spent on buses to and from lessons and carnivals.

Periodically the P&C undertakes major projects to upgrade infrastructure at the school. Past projects include the construction of the school pool, the multi-sport courts on the lower oval, and the Altius Centre.

In 2017 the P&C will continue to focus on the IT Upgrade. This year we will purchase more Desktop computers and replenish iPads.
