



Bonjour!

This term **Year 3** students have started their French learning journey by practicing simple conversation, saying their name, age and asking other people their names and getting basic information about their friends.

Je m'appelle – My name is..

Comment t'appelle-tu? / What is your name?

Comment s'appelle ton ami(e)? What is your friend's name?

Quel âge a-t-il/elle? How old is he/she? etc.

We are also learning the vocabulary for **LE CORPS / THE BODY**.

La tête- the head, la main – the hand, le pied – the foot, la jambe – the leg, les yeux – eyes, etc

We love playing the game Simon dit – Simon says and singing the song Tête, Epaule, genoux et pieds – Head, shoulders, knees and toes.

Years 4 &5 are learning to talk about the domestic animals in French *le chat – the cat, le chien – the dog, le cochon –the pig, l'oiseau – the bird, le poisson – the fish, la vache – the cow, etc.*

We are practising how to ask different kinds of questions and answers. **As-tu un animal domestique? / Do you have a pet?**

Oui, j'ai un chat. Yes, I have a cat. Non, je n'ai pas d'animal domestique. No, I don't have a pet.

J'aime mon animal de compagnie – I love mon pet.

Year 6 students are practising the vocabulary for **ZODIAC SIGNS** and doing a class survey to find out which is the most popular sign in their class.

Quel est ton signe du zodiac? What is your zodiac sign?

Mon signe du zodiac est Lion – My zodiac sign is Leo, etc.

Later this term we are going to learn the vocabulary for **Les Vacances et Le transport.**

Holiday and Transport. Tu pars en vacances? – are you going on a holiday?

Quand? – When? Samedi prochain – next Saturday, A Noël – for Christmas

Où? –Where? –En Allemagne – Germany, En Ecosse – Scotland

Comment? – How? Je prends l'avion – I'm going by plane.

Je prends le train – I'm going by train.
