### **2018 In-Term Swimming Lessons**

## **Pre-Primary - Year 3**

**Weeks 4 & 5: Monday 19 Feb – Friday 2 March**

Dear Parents,

The Education Department's In-Term Swimming Program has established appropriate water safety outcomes for all students through the implementation of an integrated teaching and assessment program, the Swimming and Water Safety Continuum. Participation in the In-Term Swimming Program provides students with the opportunity to acquire essential knowledge and understanding about a healthy lifestyle, to obtain and practice swimming and water safety skills and to develop positive attitudes towards safety in aquatic environments.

For 2018, students in Pre-Primary will participate in lessons at the Nedlands PS pool.

**All students are expected to attend these lessons.**

Lessons will commence Monday 19 February and conclude on Friday 2 March. The students will receive 10 x 40 minute lessons.

Children need to bring bathers, towel, hat, sunscreen, swimming goggles [if required] and a 'swimming' bag in which to place wet items. Please **clearly label all items** so that lost equipment can be promptly returned. The Cancer Foundation of WA recommends that children swim in a UV protection T-shirt or 'rash' vest. **Students need to bring sun-cream to apply before attending their lesson.**

## Additional swimming notifications for PP2 and Nedlands Park PP parents ONLY

Dear Pre-Primary parents,

The students from PP2 (Mrs Zeid) and Nedlands Park PP (Mrs Blakeney) will have their swimming lesson in the last time slot each day. This means they will only be dismissed from their swimming lesson at 3pm. We recognise that this is usually pick up time and are proposing these arrangements to maximise their lesson times.

The teachers will bring the students to the oval side pool gate at the conclusion of the lesson to be dismissed to parents as soon as possible after 3pm. Parents are asked NOT to enter the pool area. This will allow teachers to do their safety checks before dismissing students.

Once students have been dismissed, parents have two options. 1. You can take your child home in their wet bathers and towel or 2. Use the pool changing rooms to change your child into dry clothes. If your child is collected by Child Care, you may also elect to have the teacher supervise the child changing in the classroom. Of course, if you have a pool membership, you might choose to wait for the swimming teachers to leave and have some family time in the pool if this suits your other commitments.

All Pre-Primary parents can **park on the oval** at pick up time to make pick up easier at the slightly later time. It is unlikely that the children will be dismissed before 3:05pm. Please contact your class teacher as soon as possible if this presents a problem for your family.

Nedlands Park Pre-Primary students will walk from the off site Pre-Primary to the pool under the supervision of staff. Their bags will be transported by car to the pool.
