

COMMUNICABLE AND INFECTIOUS DISEASES

If a child is found to be suffering from any of the following communicable diseases, he/she may be excluded from school for the period stipulated against each disease by the Health Department or until cleared by the issue of a medical certificate:

Conjunctivitis, chicken pox, impetigo (school sores), measles, mumps, ringworm, and head lice.

If a case of measles is discovered in the school, all unvaccinated students will be excluded for 2 weeks.
