

# PARENT INFORMATION EVENINGS 2020

## Year One – Year Six classes.

### PURPOSE OF PARENT MEETING

- Enable the families to meet you and see how positive you are about teaching their children.
- Establish a partnership between teachers and families (identify parent coordinators for each class).
- Demonstrate your personal commitment and enthusiasm. Share your philosophy.
- Outline homework expectations in line with the school policy included on the website and in the Information Brochure.
- Explain your expectations and standards for work and behaviour.
- Set out your communication strategies such as class letter each term and how to contact you for an interview, etc.
- Give the families an oral overview of the major learning focuses for the year/term. Explain immediate themes and excursions.
- Provide a written handout for families (one handout to cover each year level) which summarizes what is expected from that year level. This can be made available, at a later date, for those who do not attend.
- Remember that you have put considerable time, thought and energy into jointly planning to provide a degree of consistency and moderation across classes teaching the same year level – this meeting allows you to prove and explain that (as well as allow for your individual differences and personalities).
- **NB: Anika and Fiona Cocks, Chair of School Board, will come in to your meeting at some point to speak to the group for 3 - 4 minutes.**
- **Supervision is not being provided for any children that come. They will need to stay with their parents in the classroom for the meeting. Parents are being encouraged to leave the children at home.**
