



# Kindergarten to Pre-Primary Transition Morning

Nedlands Primary School would like to invite your child to an orientation visit to help prepare students for Pre-Primary.

**Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> December 8:45 – 9:30 am**

**Doors will open at 8:30 if you would like to attend earlier with your child to help them be settled.**

**Parents are to take their child to the allocated Pre-Primary Centre .**

**RED group children: Parents are required to pick up students at 9:30 am.**

**BLUE Group students will remain for the remainder of their usual day.**

On Tuesday 4 December, Nedlands PS will hold a transition session to enable Kindergarten students to visit the Pre-Primary. This will help them transition smoothly into their 2019 classes.

- All children in attendance on this day will participate, unless parents make alternative arrangements.
- Students not in attendance on Tue 4 December (RED groups) are invited to attend between 8:45- - 9:30 am to participate.
- Students new to Nedlands PS, please attend your listed Pre-Primary Class for an 8:45 am start.

## **Red Group attending Nedlands Park Composite class in 2019**

RED Group students do not usually attend on Tuesdays, however we would like to invite students to participate, along with the BLUE group who would normally attend on the day. Please bring students to Nedlands Park ELC for 8:45 am if you would like your child to participate, signing the attendance sheet to show your child is in attendance. You are welcome to come to Nedlands PS (outside the library) for some refreshments while your child is participating in the transition activities (parking is available on the school oval – please drive with caution). Parents are asked to pick up RED group students from Nedlands Park ELC promptly at 9:30 am.

## **Red Group attending Onsite Pre-Primary 1 or Pre-Primary 2 in 2019**

RED Group students do not usually attend on Tuesdays, however we would like to invite students to participate along with the BLUE group who would normally attend on the day. Please bring students to the appropriate Nedlands Primary School Pre-Primary Room at 8:45 am, signing the attendance sheet to show your child is in attendance. Parking will be available on the School Oval to facilitate drop off. Please drive carefully on school grounds. Students will be supervised by teachers once in attendance. Parents are asked to pick students up from the Nedlands PS Onsite Pre-Primary promptly at 9:30 am. Tea and coffee will be available outside the Library for those who would prefer to wait at the school.

## **Blue Group attending Nedlands Park Composite class in 2019**

Please bring students to Nedlands Park ELC for 8:45 am, signing the attendance sheet to show your child is in attendance. At the end of the Transition morning the students will finish the day in their usual Kindergarten class. You are welcome to join other parents for refreshments outside the library at Nedlands PS until 9:30 am. Parking is available on the oval. Please drive carefully on the school site.

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## **Blue Group attending Onsite Pre-Primary 1 or Pre-Primary 2 in 2019**

Please bring students to Nedlands Primary School Pre-Primary Room at 8:45 am, signing the attendance sheet to show your child is in attendance. Students will be supervised by teachers once in attendance. Parking will be available on the School Oval to facilitate drop off. Please drive carefully on school grounds. You are welcome to join other parents for refreshments outside the library at Nedlands PS until 9:30 am. At the end of the Transition morning, the students will walk back to Nedlands Park Early Learning Centre and their usual Kindergarten class under the supervision of staff. They can be picked up at their usual class at the end of the day.

### **Transition**

During their transition time, the students will meet Teachers and Education Assistants. The students will spend time with all Teachers and Education Assistants so they meet **all** of the staff concerned. The students will participate in a variety of simple activities and explore their new learning areas. Please be prompt for the 8:45 am start so your child can enjoy as much time as possible at the Pre-Primary. Doors will open at 8:30 am if you would like to arrive earlier and spend some time with your child at the centre.

**This is an opportunity for students to see their Pre-Primary class, meet the staff and explore their new learning environment.**
