Welcome to term two, we hope you all had a restful term break.

We have a very busy term ahead. All the students have started training for the Cross Country competition which is being held on 30th May with the interschool cross country on the 13th June.

This term for Mathematics, students will be continuing to consolidate their knowledge of the times tables, focusing on fractions, multiplication, short division and measurement involving area, perimeter and volume. We will also be exploring time and elapsed time problems.

In Science, we will be learning about Earth and Space Sciences, looking at soil structure, rock formations, weathering and erosion. The students will also enjoy an excursion on 11th of May to Scitech.

For History, students will be learning about Early World Exploration from the 1400s – 1600s, learning about reasons for early explorations and engaging in research about early world explorers.

In English, we will continue to focus on spelling, comprehension and grammar and students will be concentrating on Biographies and Expositions.
