INSTRUCTIONS

Aim

Create a Three Levels of Australian Government Triarama that summarises the roles and responsibilities of each of the three levels of government in Australia.


You will need

- 4 sheets of square craft paper
- Three Levels of Australian Government Triarama templates
- Responsibilities of Australian Federal Government fact sheets
- Responsibilities of Australian State Governments fact sheets
- Responsibilities of Australian Local Governments fact sheets
- scissors
- glue
- colouring pencils and markers

Steps


- 1. Use the fact sheets to research the roles and responsibilities for each level of government.
- 2. Select 5 roles and responsibilities for each level of government.
- **3**. Record your chosen roles and responsibilities for each level of government on the circle templates provided (blue = federal, orange = state, green = local)
- **4**. Fold one of the sheets of square craft papers into quarters diagonally. Cut from one corner to the centre then overlap to create a three-dimensional, three-sided triagular prism. Glue the base in place.
- **5**. Repeat the process for the other 3 sheets of square craft paper then glue all four sides together.
- 6. Colour in the triarama title page.
- 7. Cut out all the templates and glue them onto the triarama creating a title page side, federal government side, state government side and local government side.
- 8. Using the tab, attach the flag to a straw and insert through the centre of the triarama.
- 9. Display and share your triaramas with the class.









Roles and Responsibilities of Australia's Federal Government








Roles and Responsibilities of Australia's State Governments
